

**CITY OF LAFAYETTE
PERMIT FEE SUMMARY
(Effective 1-10-2006)**

All dollar amounts are to rounded up to the nearest \$1,000.00 for fee calculations.

Building Permit Fee:

- \$25.00 minimum fee
- \$25.00 for the first \$1,000.00 and \$2.00 for each additional \$1,000.00 there after.
- \$00.50 per \$1,000.00 over \$1,000,000.00.

Calculation for projects under \$1,000,000.00:

$((\$25.00 \text{ (minimum)}) + ((\text{Dollar amount of project} - \$1,000.00) / (\$500.00))) = \text{permit fee total}$

Example: Project cost is \$1,250.00. You must round up to \$2,000.00.

$$\$25 + ((\$2000.00 - \$1000.00) / \$500.00) = \$25.00 + \$2.00 = \$27.00$$

Calculation for projects over \$1,000,000.00:

$(\text{Amount of project} / \$2,000.00) + \$1,523.00 = \text{permit fee total}$

Example: (amount of project is \$1,323,045.00)

round up to \$1,324,000.00 / 2000 = \$662.00 + \$1,523.00 = \$2,185.00

Stormwater/Erosion Control Permitting Fees:

- All proposed projects that disturb soil will be assessed a Stormwater/erosion control related fee. Please see the [Stormwater Permitting Fee Ordinance](#) for the current fee schedule. Erosion control fees will be assessed to the developer as part of the utility service agreement and to the lot owner during the building permitting process. Projects that disturb over 1 (one) acre of soil will require a construction stormwater/erosion permit in addition to the required fees.

Re-Inspection Fines:

- First Inspection & Re-Inspection: No Charge
- Additional Re-Inspections: \$25.00 per re-inspection
- Occupying building without Certificate of Occupancy: \$50.00 (Ordinance #2001-11)

Sanitary/Storm Sewer Tap Fee:

- \$200.00 - Residential
- \$400.00 - Non-residential/storm

Water Tap Fee:

- \$600.00 - per tap

General Permits:

- \$50.00 - Sanitary Sewer Seal
- \$10.00 - Residential driveways
- \$25.00 - Non-residential driveways
- \$10.00 - Excavating
- \$10.00 - New sidewalk
- \$00.00 - Existing sidewalk
- \$00.00 - Moving oversize loads - the road route needs to be approved by the **Traffic Department**
